This Indenture made this eleventh day of February in the year of Our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Ninety and in the fourteenth year of American Independance between Isaham Cawdle of the County of Chatham in the State of North Carolina of the one part and Allin Hudson of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Isaham Cawdle for and in the Consideration of the Sum of one hundred pounds & pecuny to him in hand paid by the said Allin Hudson the receipt whereof he doth acknowledge the said Isaham Cawdle hath granted Bargain and Sold and by these presents doth Bargain and Sell unto the said Allin Hudson his heirs and assigns one Certain Tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred Acres more or less lying on the Waters of Little Beaver Creek in the County of Chatham in the aforesaid State and bounded as followz Beginning at a Red Oak on Cawdles line thence a North Course to a Black Gum thence an East Course to a Black Oak thence a South Course to a Red Oak thence to the head of a little Branch (down said Branch to a Willow Oak on the great Branch thence West to first Station Together with all Woods, Water & Water Courses standing growing and being the Reversion and Reversionary Remainder & Remainders and all the Estate Right Title Intrust Claim and Demand whatsoever of him the said Isaham Cawdle of in or to the said premises or any part thereof to have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of Land & premises together with the Appurtanances unto the said Allin Hudson his heirs and assigns forever to the only use and behoof of him the said Allin Hudson his heirs and assigns forever and the said Isaham Cawdle for him and his heirs the said Land and premises with the Appurtanances unto the said Allin Hudson his heirs and assigns will warrant and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Isaham Cawdle doth herunto set his hand & his Seal in presence
