This Indenture made this Eleventh day of Feb. in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety &
in the fourteenth year of the American Independence between
Isaham Cawdle of the County of Chatham in the State of North
Carolina of the one part and William Hudson Jun. of the County
and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Isaham Cawdle and in the Consideration of the Sum of one hundred
pounds Spacy to him in hand paid by the S. William Hudson
Jun. the receipt whereof he doth acknowledge the S. Isaham
Cawdle hath granted Bargain and sold and by these presents
doth Bargain and Sell unto the S. William Hudson Juner his
heirs and assigns one certain Tract or parcel of Land contain-
ing one hundred Acres be it More or less lying on the North side
Little Beaver Creek in the County of Chatham in the aforesaid
State bounded as follows Beginning at a White Oak on Beaver
Creek thence to North Course to a Red Oak on Cawdleys line thence
East Course to a Mellow Oak on a great Branch thence down
the S. Branch to the Beaver Creek thence down the S. Creek to
the first Station Together with all Woods, Water and Water
Courses standing growing & being the Reversion & Reversion's re-
mainder & Remainders and all the Estate Right Title Intrust claim
or Demand whatsoever of him the S. Isaham Cawdle of in or to
