 hundred and ninety five Between William Brewer of
 Chloae his Wife of North Carolina Chatham County of
 the one part and Charles White Jun^r of the State and County
 aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said
 William Brewer and Chloae his Wife for and in Consider-
 ation of the sum of seventy pounds to them in hand paid
 by Charles White Jun^r the receipt whereof they the said
 William Brewer and Chloae his Wife doth hereby acknow-
 ledge and themselves fully satisfied Contented and paid
 have Bargained sold and delivered, and by these presents
 doth Bargain sell deliver Alien enfeof release and forever
 confirm unto Charles White Jun^r him his heirs Execu-
 tors and Administrators, or assigns, one certain Tract or
 parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid
 on the Waters of Tick Creek Beginning at a black Oak
 on original Corner in George Dicoon's line running North
 89 poles to two George thence East 180 poles to a black
 Oak thence South 89 poles to a black oak thence West 180
 poles to the Beginning containing one hundred Acres, it being
 part of a Tract of Land that John Brewer Jun^r obtained a grant
 for bearing date October 1782 and also the reversion and re-
 versions, Remainder and remainders, Rents, Issues, and Services,
 thereof and also all the Estate right Title Interest property claim
 and demand whatsoever of him the said William Brewer and his
 Wife Chloae them their heirs, Executors & Administrators, unto
