This Indenture made the twentieth day of
June --- in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred Seventy
One Between William Johnson Esqr presiding Justice in the
County of Bute & Province *** on behalf of the Justices of the sd. County
and these (illegible) of the one part and George Wooton of the sd. County
of the other part Witnesseth that the sd. William Johnson pursuant to an Order of the said
County Court dated February Court last, and according to the act of assembly in that case made
and provided doth put place & Bind unto the sd. George Wooton
one Moses Caudle orphan of Mary Caudle Dec'd aged
five year + three months at the time of the afores^d order
of Court with the said George Wooton to live after the
manner of an apprentice and servant until the said Moses Caudle
shall attain the age of Twenty one Years during which time
the sd. Apprentice his sd. Master shall Faithfully Serve, his law-
full Commands every where gladly obey he shall not at any time
absent him self from his sd. Masters Service with out leave, but in
all things as a good & faith full Servant Shall behave towards his said
Master, and the sd. Master doth Covenant promise & agree to & with
The said William Johnson that he will teach & Instruct or Cause
to be taught & Instructed the sd. Apprentice in the Business of a
Planter ----- and that he will constantly
find and provide for him Sufficient Diet, washing, lodgings and
apparel and all other Neccessities as well in sickness & in health
during the time of his Service In witness where of the parties
to these presents have Interchangably set there hands & Seals the day
and year first above Written
